When did you fall behind?

My Last Tracked D	When was the last time in Craftybase that your CB numbers represented your actual stock on the shelf? This is your Last Tracked Date (LTD).	
If there is a significant amount of time between now and your LTD, and/or you cannot recreate your purchase & manufacture records, consider resetting your account and following our <u>Getting Started Guide</u> instead.		
From	ter missing purchases om your LTD up to today, ensure that all historical purchases of iterials are entered and marked as received.	
Fro	reate missing manufactures om your LTD up to today, ensure that all batches of products made ve been entered as manufactures.	
Per cre <u>Wo</u>	ocktake your materials  erform a manual stocktake of all materials you have on hand by eating a Material Stocktake or printing out your Physical Material orksheet. Account for any differences via adding adjustments, if cessary.	
Rev	eview orders eview your imported orders to ensure that they are all accounted for rectly. Enter any missing sales from offline or unsupported channels.	
Ger stoo	nerate your <u>Physical Product Worksheet</u> and then perform a manual cktake of all on hand product to compare numbers. Account for any ferences via adding <u>adjustments</u> , if necessary.
